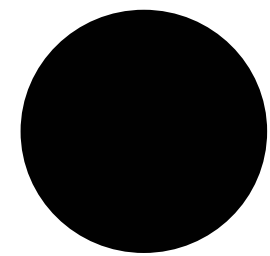

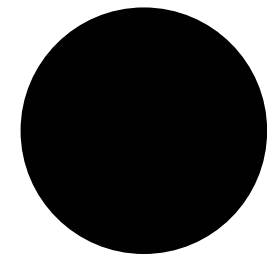

KOŠICE

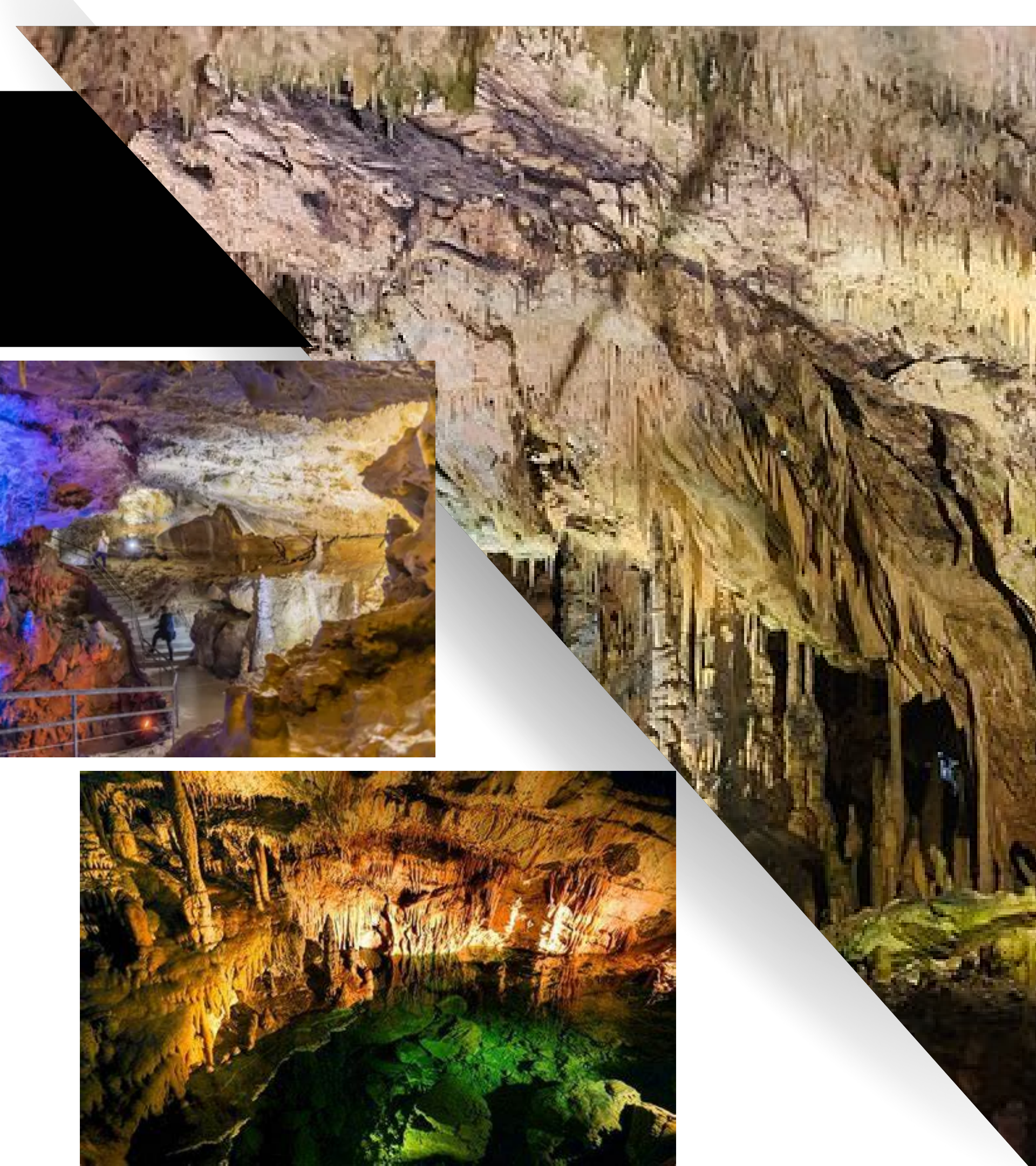
Bratislava serves as the capital and largest city, while the second largest city is Košice.
